# Estimated School Expenses 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to another busy school year at Engadine Public School. It will be an exciting year for our students with plenty of opportunities to participate in excursions, camps, extracurricular opportunities, sports, and various community events. These opportunities are an integral part of a student's education and development.

Of course, these opportunities and activities come at an additional cost. We are aware of increased cost of living expenses, and so we have endeavoured to limit the number of excursions and camps, as well as select specialist curricular options that offer reduced costs. To enable families to budget, we have put together a summary of costs for you to consider, relevant to your child's Stage.

Please note there may be additional incidental costs that arise over the coming months that we are not yet aware of or able to cost, depending on opportunities that become available. Therefore, while this is a guide, it is not an exhaustive list. We will always aim to give you as much notice as possible of upcoming costs. If you are unable to pay school costs because of financial hardship, you may be eligible for assistance from the school.
