K-6 Science and Technology Incursions

During Term 3 we celebrate National Science Week. It is Australia's annual celebration of Science and Technology. Years K-2 will be participating in Jollybops Science Shows and Years 3 -6 will be participating in a Forensic Science Investigation.

K-2 - Jollybops Monday 18th August

Year 3-6 – Education Interactive – Forensic Science Tuesday 12th August Cost: \$9.00

Kindergarten will enjoy the Balloon Science Show, (Fun with Forces).

A show full of Fantastic Science experiments, most with the humble balloon. These include exploding Hydrogen balloons, Spooky fog, Dry Ice expanding balloon head, Soapy sudsy bubbling Dry Ice cylinder, Pop off tins, Balloon in a bottle race, Balloon helicopters, Colour change reactions, Liquid Nitrogen air balloons along with everything that Pops and Fizzes. Students will take part in all experiments as they laugh along with the jokes, pantomime and occasional Science song of Rusty the Robot & Jolly Professor, all in one great show.

Years 1 and 2 will be participating in the Moove & Groove with Energy Show, (Forms of Energy).

This show explores the concepts of Energy (energy makes things move or work), different types of Energy (heat, light, electrical & sound) along with the varying sources of Energy (sun, food, batteries & fuels). Visually dynamic these student interactive experiments will keep them on the edge of their seats. Students will explore a myriad of Energy emitting, absorbing or transforming experiments from exploding Sun Fuel, Food fireballs, Kinetic vortices, Colours in Fireworks, Liquid Nitrogen Egg freeze, Cool Dry Ice reactions, Screaming Balloons and the popular Sound Cup Competition.
