Dear Parents

Term 4 is a very busy term with a number of big events. Our "Laps for Literacy" happens on Wednesday, 19 October followed by our Art Show and Grandparents' Day in November and then we have the Year 6 musical "Olivia", Year 6 Farewell and Presentation Day in December.

Speaking of the Art Show, I have had a chance last week to look at some of the works that will be on display and I just cannot believe the quality of the pieces that will be on show. I remember well what I produced as a child at school, those stick figures, poorly formed paintings that my mother lovingly kept. What will be on show will certainly make our students, staff and community extremely proud. Also coming up this Term is the election of our 2012 Leaders. The 2012 Year 6 students have been given information outlining the procedure that is in place for the election. The students have also discussed the expectations of the role of leader and they have been asked to consider this well before nominating.

Later this Term, I will be sending home some surveys which I would encourage all to take the opportunity to spend a few minutes to fill in. These surveys are anonymous, and at this stage, it is planned that they will be on-line so completion will be but a few mouse clicks.

Recently, parents of our current Years 4 & 5 have been surveyed about the multi-day excursions that Stage 3 students attend. From the surveys it was apparent that there was substantial support for these to continue in 2012. Shortly, all families of 2012 Stage 3 students (current Y4 & Y5) will receive a note outlining the two excursions and the approximate cost. This will enable some saving to be done. For convenience, the school will offer a banking scheme for parents so that they can deposit \$10 here and \$10 there to assist in reaching the target as painlessly as possible. I recognise that these excursions do impact on the household budget and should a family find themselves in a position where their child may not be able to attend due to financial constraints, please contact either Hazel or myself.

#### GREEN, RED, ORANGE HANDS



### Are you going 'Trick or Treating' for Halloween?

The NSW Police Force recommends that you do not participate in "trick or treating". However, if you choose to participate, here are some things you should consider:

- Is it safe to take lollies or chocolate from strangers?
- Do I know the person that lives in the house I am door knocking?
- Will I get into trouble from police if I play a 'prank' or damage property?
- What if a stranger talks to me?

#### **Remember NSW Police Safety Tips:**

- Safety in numbers!
- Walk in a group never walk alone.
- Ensure you have adult supervision.
- Hold hands and cross roads at safe locations such as marked crossings and/or traffic light intersections. Don't forget to 'Stop, Look, Listen and Think.'
- Do not take lollies, chocolate from strangers.
- Do not talk to strangers other than the people nominated as 'Safe people' from 'Safe places'
- If you feel unsafe or unsure remember to tell a stranger 'No' 'Go away" and then tell a grown up about what happened.

# If you would still like to celebrate the occasion, perhaps you could consider celebrating at home.

- Police will not tolerate poor behaviour, particularly in public so remember your manners just like every other day of the year. Do not throw any objects such as water bombs and eggs at anyone or any property as this is an offence.
