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#### Dear Parents

#### <u>NAPLAN</u>

Our NAPLAN results have arrived and it is now time to start looking at what all the data can tells us to assist in shaping what we do in the future. As an example, our spelling results, whilst not too bad, could be better and so this year we have changed the way spelling is being taught in the classroom. We are starting to see improvements with trend lines heading upward.

Perhaps the most important piece of data for us is the growth factor. Students who sat Naplan here in Year 3 are tracked with their results in both tests compared and a growth factor established. In the areas of Grammar and Punctuation, Spelling and Numeracy our growth factor was considerably higher than the average of all NSW schools and all Government schools. Reading was the only area that was below these two averages. Our reaction to this result begins with a very detailed evaluation of each student's performance. Which question did they have correct? Which did they have wrong? What answer to they put instead of the correct answer? In doing this, we will be looking for areas where the skill level of our Y5 students is not up to the level it should be. Once we establish this, then we start looking at what and how we are teaching these skills and then what are we going to do to ensure that these skills are consolidated.

Highlights include our Year 5 boys being 51 points higher in Spelling and our Year 3 girls being well above the reading average for the State. It was indeed pleasing to see that 75% of our Year 3 students are in the top 2 bands for writing.

#### <u>Leaders</u>

Our current Year 5 students will very soon be given the opportunity to participate in the elections for 2013 School Leaders. The students will shortly be given information outlining the election process which will culminate in the announcement of our new leaders at our Presentation Day on Tuesday, 11 December.

Speaking of Leadership, it was extremely pleasing to see Engadine ex-students Grady Smith and Emma Free elected to leadership roles at their high schools. Grady is the incoming Captain of Heathcote High School whilst Emma is an incoming Prefect at Engadine High School. Congratulations to both of these students! They are fine examples of our ex-student body.

#### P&C Support

At the last P & C Meeting, a very generous sum of \$10,000 was given to the school. This donation will help our students in a number of areas:

- Additional laptops and wireless access points to allow us to set up a cord-free, go-almost-anywhere learning centre within the school.
- Funding for the purchase of additional literacy resources providing extra Home Reading books, big books, interactive resources.
- Tactile calming devices to assist students at times of stress and anxiety.
- Funding to freshen-up line marking within the playground.
- Funding to replace existing soft fall material under our play equipment

The P&C have worked hard over the past 12 months to raise funds and it is great to see that our students will soon be benefiting as a result of their hard work.

The Yrs 3-6 were first out on the walking path and they were making short work of their laps when K-2 joined them. There was a large number of our community on hand to cheer on the kids. There was more than one or two yummy picnics set up to keep the pre-schoolers well fuelled.

As the morning wore on, the kids took advantage of the "P&C Pit Stop". With a drink and sausage sandwich under the belt, the remaining laps were polished off quite quickly.

Joining the students as they clocked up their laps were a number of parents, pre-schoolers, prams and grandparents all doing their bit to support their children.

It was indeed a great day and the P&C deserve a big thankyou as they were certainly well organised to cope with the ravenous tribe.

It is to parents and community members that a big, big thank you is also needed – your support financial and in being present, makes it a very meaningful event.




We are once again having our **Carols Night** on Thursday, 6 December. This is a relaxed way to celebrate the year and enjoy the coming Christmas season.
