School Bytes

We have decided not to renew out license for the SkoolBag App as we have just not been getting the service we had paid for. We have been having ongoing issues receiving some of the absence notifications which parents have lodged with the App over the last 6 to 9 months and could not rely on it. We have now introduced School Bytes which is not an App but runs through your email. Could you please check your emails for messages from the school email Engadine-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au as we have already begun using School Bytes to send you notes and reminders and some have bounced back to us. We are endeavoring to phone families who are on this bounce log but we need to have a viable email address so you don't miss out on these messages. Please also check that our messages don't go into your spam folder. If you change your email address please let us know so we can update our records. School Bytes is far superior to SkoolBag having the capacity to send you financial statements as well as newsletters, reminders and notes direct to your email. Accessible 24/7, it gives YOU the option of linking up to our financial system and looking to see what fees are outstanding or credits you may have on your account. It gives you the option to quickly and easily pay any or all items via our secure online payment facility POP. So if you use POP it's now not necessary to find the correct money, students don't need to be responsible for large sums of cash in their bags and there's no change to be lost or spent at the canteen! Please note School Bytes does not currently have the ability for you to send us absence notifications but may be added later in the year. Please email or phone the school with these for longer absences or for short absences bring a note for your teacher when your child returns to school. We hope you enjoy using School Bytes. Give it a try!

School Band & Ukulele Troupe Update

Thank you to families who have already indicated their interest in being part of our Band and Ukulele Troupe this year. There are still positions available if your child would like to join either or both groups.

We are introducing Ukulele for the first time at our school this year. This will be a fun opportunity to learn this instrument and experience music. Mr Jared Dahl, a parent from our school, will be the tutor and will conduct a 45 minute lesson on Thursday afternoons, from 3.45pm. Additional lessons may be added if the troupe grows in the future. Ukulele Instrument hire will be \$10 per Term.

Mr Archie Rowlands will be our new tutor for Band this year. His proposes to run 2 x 30 minute tutorials on Tuesday mornings from 8.00am plus a combined one hour session on Thursday mornings from 8.00am to 9.00am. A commitment of 2 mornings per week. Band instrument hire will be \$20 per Term. The cost is the same for both programs at \$12 per lesson plus instrument hire payable by the Term. Term 1 will consist of 5 weeks tutorial and will commence next week on Tuesday, 12 March for Band and Thursday, 14 March for Ukulele. Terms 2, 3 & 4 will consist of approximately 10 weeks tutorial including any additional lessons or performances as needed
